Welcome Back

It was lovely to welcome all the children back this week after the Summer break and every one of them looked really smart in their uniform. I would also like to extend a warm welcome to all the families new to St Wilfrid's.

Start and Finish Times

From next Monday, 6th September, start and finish times will change. I have enclosed a revised timetable with this letter and all your children have been told where they need to enter and exit school each day. Although class "bubbles" have now stopped we are still advised to help maintain social distancing, especially between adults. To prevent congestion on and around the school grounds we ask that you keep your distance from other families. With the exception of Nursery the doors to all classrooms will be open for 5 minutes between 8:50am and 8:55am. The children will **NOT** be asked to line up in the playground but instead will be asked to make their way to their classrooms from 8:50am. Pick up times are also included in the enclosed timetable and each child will leave school through the same door they entered in the morning. Could parents of children in Nursery, Reception and Year 6 please note the finish times for their children. All other children will finish at 3:00pm.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club will be available for children from Reception class and above from Monday morning to assist parents with work and other commitments. It will be open from 8:00am and we will not be able to take any children after 8:40am. The children will be provided with the choice of toast or cereals and a healthy drink. They will be supervised and provided with Reading and/or drawing materials. They may bring their own reading book should they wish. The cost is £1 each day, paid daily or preferably £5 at the start of each week.

COVID

If your child has any of the 3 major symptoms of COVID please keep them at home and arrange for a PCR test. If your child is absent, for this or any other reason, please contact the school by telephone (not email) before 9:30am.

Over the next few days each class teacher will be in contact with you with details and specific information for your child's class.
